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Community Health Plans





- July 1: Transparency in Coverage Rule went into effect—plans must post machine-readable files with prices for all covered services.
- July 8: President Biden issues Executive Order to protect access to contraceptive and abortion services post-Roe v. Wade overturning
- July 8: CBO said legislation allowing Medicare to negotiate prescription drug prices would save \$290 billion over 10 years
- July 15: PHE extended
- The latest on:
 - FTC's pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) investigation
 - **Congressional action** on reconciliation package, USCIA / COMPETES





How the PHE Affected Lab Testing

Increased Consumer-Friendly Delivery Methods

- Emergency Use Authorizations
- Free, mail-order tests
- Legislation requiring plans to cover tests



Unresolved Issues

- Lack of competitive pricing—price-gouging, price transparency of lab test prices
- Lack of reporting/oversight of DTC testing (duplicative testing, incomplete results, and need for consumer education)





Where Patients Get Lab Services Will Matter

- According to the No Surprises Act, hospital labs cannot balance bill, but doctor office-ordered labs can
- Cost pressure has everything under a microscope—will value-based contracting mean labs are in bundled payments?







Future Lab Testing Issues for Plans

New Frontier—Discretionary Lab Testing

- Insurance coverage questions
- Advanced molecular and genetic testing
 - What expensive treatments will they lead to?

Prior Authorization Scrutiny

- OIG report: MA plans denied some prior authorization requests
- House Energy & Commerce Subcommittee held hearing on MA oversight
- Improving Seniors' Timely Access to Care Act
- CMS is working with ONC to streamline prior authorizations
